Soteriades just completed her ninth season as Head Field Hockey Coach at Denison University. During



that time she has guided the Big Red to six top four finishes in the conference, an NCAC Championship in 2000, and an appearance in the NCAA Division III Tournament. In addition to being named 2002 NCAC Coach of the Year she has coached numerous individuals that have received high honors. Over the last nine years the Big Red has placed nineteen players on the ALL-NCAC First-Team. Soteriades has coached the Offensive Player of the Year in 2002, 2003, 2005 and the Defensive Player of the year in 2006. For three consecutive years, a Big Red Freshman was named as the conference "Newcomer of the Year" (2000, 2001 and 2002). A 2000 graduate of Ohio University, Soteriades was a three-year member of the Division I Field Hockey Program after playing her freshman season at Ball State University. During her senior year at Ohio she served as a team captain.

CAMP LOCATION

Camp is located at the beautiful rolling hill campus of Denison University. Located just 30 miles east of downtown Columbus, Denison provides an excellent setting for camp that is easily accessible and centrally located. Campers will play on the new hybrid turf field along in addition to the grass field hockey fields. Resident campers will have the unique opportunity to sample college living while attending camp by staying in the campus resident halls. Resident halls are safe and well supervised. Meals will be served in the campus dining halls. Commuter campers will receive lunch and dinner. Dinner is the first meal on the first day of camp and breakfast will be the last meal on the final day of camp.

A shuttle service will be provided for campers arriving by plane to the Columbus Airport (CMH). The shuttle fee is \$40 each way or \$80 round trip. Campers that will be traveling by plane can make arrangements in the registration confirmation that will be sent out to all campers upon receipt of camp deposit.
